## FAQs

Q: Is there an admission cost?

A: Because of the awesome support of Grandpa's Cheesebarn and the Ashland County Park District's mission, this is a FREE event (on occasion some vendors may have items for sale).

Q: Is this event a drive through installation?

A: No, this is a WALKING event, but there are select nights that the Ashland County Park district will offer golf cart rides for those who are mobility impaired. Please see their Facebook page for more information at: https://www.facebook.com/ashlandctyparks

Q: Is the trail open during the day?

A: Yes, the Freer Field walking path is open, but the lights will not be lit. The display will be lit nightly starting at dusk until 9:30 PM through January 1st (tentatively).

Q: How long does the trail take to walk?

A: Depending on how busy the trail is, expect to spend 30-60 minutes. But this really depends on your pace as this is a self-guided installation.

Q: Are pets allowed?

A: Leashed pets are allowed per park policy.

O: Are there concessions available?

A: On select times there may be concession vendors on site, but not nightly.

Q: Who puts on the Candy Cane Trail?

A: Candy Cane Trail is a dazzling holiday feat first imagined by Richard & Ronda Poorbaugh of Grandpa's Cheesebarn. It is a public-private partnership between the Ashland County Park District and Grandpa's Cheesebarn. Other parties have made contributions in making the event a huge success as well.
